You are entitled to appoint one or more proxies and the proxy need not be a shareholder of the Company but must attend the Meeting in person to represent you.

In the absence of any such indication, the proxy may vote for or against the resolution or may abstain at his discretion. Your proxy will also be entitled to vote at his discretion on any resolution properly put to the Meeting other than those referred to in the Notice.
5. This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or, in case of a corporation, must be either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney or other person duly authorised.

Where there are joint holders of share(s), any one of such joint holders may vote at the Meeting, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such share(s) as if he/she were solely entitled thereto, but if more than one of such joint holders be present at the Meeting personally or by proxy, that one of the said persons so present whose name stands first on the register of members of the Company in respect of such share(s) shall alone be entitled to vote and will be accepted to the exclusion of other joint registered holders in respect hereof.

To be valid, this form of proxy together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed (or a notarially certified copy thereof) must be deposited at the Company’s branch registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen’s Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time fixed for holding the Meeting or at any adjournment thereof.

The completion of a form of proxy and returning it to the Company’s branch registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the Meeting or poll concerned and, in such event, the appointment of the proxy will be deemed to be revoked.

PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION STATEMENT

Your and your proxy’s Personal Data will be disclosed or transferred to the Company’s branch registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong and/or other companies or bodies for the purpose stated above, or when it is required to do so by law, for example, in response to a court order or a law enforcement agency’s request, and will be retained for such period as may be necessary for the Company’s verification and record purpose.

By providing your proxy’s Personal Data in this form, you should have obtained the express consent (which has not been withdrawn in writing) from your proxy in using his/her Personal Data provided in this form and that you have informed your proxy of the purpose for and the manner in which his/her data may be used.
